The interns will be able to participate in all steps of the Surveying as the project preparation, engineering, pre and post-survey data processing in order to monitor marine environments during all phases of projects and build respective documentation. During the Internship they will attain invaluable skills and industry knowledge with the potential of becoming permanent member of Asso group.

- Project Preparation
  - Assists in the verification of the accuracy of survey data, including measurements and calculations conducted at the project area;
  - Assists in the preparation of each project's DTM model and unloads of project related survey data;
  - Assists in the preparation of the project survey database;
  - Assists in preparation of project execution documentation, maps, drawings etc.;
- Project Execution
  - Assists in the project mobilization phase in terms of survey equipment, navigation and positing system (NaviPac) set-up;
  - Assists in survey equipment calibration and verification operations, which include:
    - Multibeam echosounders;
    - Cable/pipe trackers (TSS);
    - Side Scan Sonars;
  - Online MBE/TSS data acquisition;
  - Prepares preliminary as-build/as-laid/as-buried drawings, charts for submission to the client;

  - Assists in the preparation of final documentation of the projects: eg. built drawings, alignment charts, burial graphs, maps, records and documents related to surveys
